




- Australian Beef Herd –currently estimated at 25.2 million head

- Herd numbers state by state





- CIQ work with exporters at every stage of the supply chain




- Australia's disease free status sis significant

- Quarantine in China is 45 days
 Voyage duration is 16 18 days
- New regulations in Australia require more space per animal for the voyage meaning less animals on the ship




Australia's Live Export markets

Australian live cattle exports*




